Liversedge Half Marathon Privacy Notice

As the organisers of Liversedge Half Marathon (LHM) Roberttown Road Runners (RRR) are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. For any personal data you provide for the purposes of your participation in LHM, RRR is the Data Controller and is responsible for storing and otherwise processing that data in a fair, lawful, secure and transparent way.

What personal data we hold about you

You may give us information about you by filling in entry forms online or by corresponding with us by phone, email or otherwise. The information you give us may include (but not be limited to) your name, date of birth, address, e-mail address, phone number, names of the England Athletics (EA) affiliated clubs with which you are registered, EA URN number, emergency contact details, gender, clothing size and predicted finish time.

Why we need your personal data

The reason we need your personal data is to be able to provide the services you are signing up for when you enter LHM. Our lawful basis for processing your personal data is that we have a contractual obligation to you as a participant to provide the services you are registering for. We will not use your data for any reason other than the administration of LHM.

The LHM has a Facebook page. All participants and volunteers are free to join this page. If you join the Facebook pages, please note that Facebook have their own privacy policies and that the club do not accept any responsibility or liability for these policies. Please check these policies before you submit any personal data on the event Facebook page.

Who we share your personal data with

We will publish your personal data as part of the results of the LHM and may pass such information to the governing body or any affiliated organisation for the purpose of insurance, licences or for publishing results either for the event alone or combined with or compared to other events. Results may include (but not be limited to) name, any club affiliation, race times and age category. We will also pass your details on to our chosen timing company for the event. Your personal information will be gathered via an online race booking service¹.

How long we hold your personal data

We will hold your personal data for one month after the publication of the full race results at which point it will be destroyed. Your personal data which has been published as part of the race results will continue to be available for one year on the RRR website (<u>https://www.roberttownroadrunners.co.uk</u>). Should you be successful in breaking a course record this information will be published through the RRR website and race information until such time as the record is broken.

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject you may have the right at any time to request access to, rectification or erasure of your personal data; to restrict or object to certain kinds of processing of your personal data, including direct marketing; to the portability of your personal data and to complain to the UK's data protection supervisory authority, the Information Commissioner's Office about the processing of your personal data.

As a data subject you are not obliged to share your personal data with RRR. If you choose not to share your personal data with us we may not be able administer your participation in the LHM.
